Trail Description

When completed this trail will travel from the East Bay Skyline National Trail in Wildcat Canyon Regional Park, down the east bay hills through the cities of San Pablo and Richmond to connect to the SF Bay Trail along the San Pablo Bay shoreline. Along this trail is the site of a major restoration project at Wildcat Creek. Native rainbow trout, transplanted from Redwood Regional Park, are being reintroduced. When completed the trail will be approximately 9.5 miles long.
